

Household Church

We would love to share a guideline of how to do church at home for the next few weeks.

Please try to limit your gatherings to about 10 people.

1. Open up your time together in prayer. Spend a few minutes prayerfully praising him and thanking him for all that He is and all that He has done, and all that He is doing in your life.

Psalm 100: 3- 4 says, “Know that the Lord is God. IT is He who made us, and we are His; We are His people, and the sheep of His pasture. Enter His gates with Thanksgiving and His courts with praise; give thanks to Him and bless His name. For the Lord is good, and His loving devotion endures forever; His faithfulness continues to all generations.

2. Find a scripture that provokes praise in you and read that out aloud for everyone to hear. The psalms are full of wonderful truths of the nature of God. The epistles have a number of very encouraging doxologies. Here are a few suggestions:

Rom 8:38-39, Rom 11:33- 36, Eph 1:4-10, Eph 3:17-19, Eph 3:20-21, 1 Tim 6:15-16, Jude 24-25;
Rev 1:5-6 ; Rev 5:12-13

3. Put on some worship, sing three to four songs. Here is a list of songs that we are currently doing in Godfirst church.

Feel free to create space for members of your house to pray out, share prophetic hymns or prophetic words.

4. Close your worship time with prayer.
5. Play the video supplied by Godfirst Church East Rand. It will include an introduction, possibly some notices and then the word for the day.
6. Pray for each other as the spirit leads you in line with the word shared.
7. Take communion and celebrate all that Christ has done for you.
 - a. Read the instruction given by Paul in 1 Corinthians 11 : 23 – 32.
 - b. Allow for a moment of repentance.
 - c. Allow for a moment of reflection and remembrance.
 - d. Take communion.

8. Close the service in prayer.

The service should take between 1 hour and 1 hour 30 mins depending on the length of your worship time and your response time.
